Free Childcare Scheme Expanded

Northumberland County Council is expanding a free childcare scheme for two-year-olds. Since September 2013 the government has provided 15 hours of free funded education (570 hours a year) to 20% of two-year-olds from the term following their second birthday. Now NCC is now extending this free entitlement to 40% of two-year-olds from summer 2014, a term earlier than the Government requires. The main expanded criteria is that families in receipt of Working Tax Credit (annual gross earning of no more than £16,190 per year) will now become eligible, resulting in over 1,300 eligible children across Northumberland.
