Reading Focus

One of our whole-school focuses this year is Reading. We are very proud of the standards the children reach in school with their reading thanks to the efforts of our wonderful teachers and support staff but also, as importantly, through your help at home. However, some research has indicated that there is a decline in reading at home generally when children begin Primary school. I intend to raise the profile of Reading across the school this year through several measures. Naturally, your support at home, continuing to read with your child and to ask them questions about what they are reading is vital. We ensure that the children's speech and language is as good as it can be in order to act as a firm foundation for reading, discussion and the inquiry that this will bring. We also need to ensure that the children comprehend what they have read and are able to answer and ask questions about the text as well as draw conclusions from inferences made in a story or article. We are going to relaunch our School Library this year with some new librarians, chosen from across the school. I would also like us all to be a little more interactive, sharing ideas on what makes a good book, for example and getting the children to choose their top 5 favourite reads. We will also be having a Reading Focus Week and inviting parents into school again to get involved in the learning. Reading and comprehension is the gateway to so many things that we will encounter in life and it can open up completely new worlds and stimulate our imagination.

To start us off, we have managed to obtain some free books for Willow class - a story called "The Bumblebear" and these will be given out free to all Reception children as soon as possible. I hope you enjoy them!
