A warm welcome back to everyone after the Christmas break and a belated Happy New Year! I really hope that you enjoyed your Christmas and spending time with family and friends. It was lovely to see the children back in our first whole-school assembly of the term on Tuesday morning. In that assembly, I talked to the children about some of the things we have planned for this half term which is already looking very busy. Towards the end of the half term we will be having a whole school focus on e-safety, reminding children how to stay safe when using the internet in school and also at home. It is extremely important for children to ensure that they are using the internet safely and responsibly, particularly at this time of year when perhaps children may have received various electronic devices at Christmas. On our INSET Teacher Training day on Monday January 5th, I arranged for Northumberland Local Authority to present to all staff in school about e-safety and safeguarding in general so that as parents and carers, you can be sure we are up to date with the latest statutory requirements and thinking. At our Tuesday assembly, Mr Layton introduced our new, whole-school creative project "Portal Design" to the children. You may remember I sent a letter home just before Christmas to let you know of our plans and you had an additional letter about it yesterday. The children are very excited about the project and can't wait to get started so please take some time to ask them about what will be happening this half term. We are talking to the children about expectations and initial plans this week so that they are all set for the start next Monday. If you have any questions please speak to your child's class teacher.

We are making a slight change to one of our school awards this term. We will no longer be having Top Table every Friday as I feel that this initiative has probably run its course now and perhaps needs to be refreshed. Rather than have lunch with children at Top Table on Friday, my aim is to join the children more regularly through the week for their lunch on a more ad hoc basis. It will be nice for me to be able to sit with lots of different children over the coming weeks and talk more informally with them on a wide range of topics.

Instead, I will be launching "Star Of The Week" and "Star Tea". At our Friday assembly, each class teacher will choose one child who has worked really hard, made particular progress, has shown high standards of behaviour or perhaps demonstrated an act of kindness. They will receive a "Star Of The Week" certificate from me and will be invited to join me for "Star Tea" the following Wednesday afternoon for about 15 minutes. If the children have a favourite song they can choose to hear it at "Star Tea" and we will share some snacks and a drink together. It will be a lot of fun and a lovely reward for all their hard work. I will be telling the children all about it at tomorrow's assembly.
